The Board of Preble County Commissioners is currently accepting proposals for vendors interested in supplying procurement card(s) as an approved vendor under the Preble County Procurement Card Program.

Procurement cards are designed to make small-dollar purchases made via in-store, mail, email, internet, telephone, or fax, but are restricted to a specific vendor.

Preble County recognizes a permissible procurement card as being an account card with no third party involved. In other words, the vendor will directly bill Preble County for the payment due.

Proposals shall consist of an account card application which state the account card's terms and conditions. There is no deadline for submittal. The Board of Preble County Commissioners will continue to accept proposals on an on-going basis. The proposals will be evaluated and assessed for compliance with the Preble County Procurement Card Policy.

All proposals shall be submitted to Connie L. Crowell, Commission Clerk, Board of Preble County Commissioners, 101 East Main Street, Eaton, Ohio 45320. Approved vendors will be notified within thirty (30) days of receipt of proposal.

The Board of Preble County Commissioners reserves the right to waive any irregularities and the right to reject any and all proposals.
